# John

# The Word Was God

- In the beginning awas the Word, and the bWord was cwith God, and the Word was dGod.
- 2 <sup>a</sup>The same was in the beginning with God.
- 3 <sup>a</sup>All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.
- 4 <sup>a</sup>In him was life; and <sup>b</sup>the life was the light of men.
- 5 And athe light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.
- 6 There was a aman sent from God, whose name was John.
- 7 The same came for a <sup>a</sup>witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all *men* through him might <sup>b</sup>believe.
- 8 He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that <sup>a</sup>Light.
- 9 *aThat* was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.
- 10 He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and athe world knew him not.
- 11 <sup>a</sup>He came unto <sup>1</sup>his own, and <sup>2</sup>his own received him not.
- 12 But <sup>a</sup>as many as received him, to them gave he <sup>1</sup>power to become the <sup>2</sup>sons of God, *even* to them that believe on his name:
- <sup>13</sup> <sup>a</sup>Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

<sup>14</sup> <sup>a</sup>And the Word <sup>b</sup>was<sup>1</sup> made <sup>c</sup>flesh, and dwelt among us, (and <sup>d</sup>we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) <sup>e</sup>full of grace and truth.

#### John's Witness of Christ

- 15 <sup>a</sup>John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, <sup>b</sup>He that cometh after me <sup>1</sup>is preferred before me: <sup>c</sup>for he was before me.
- 16 And of his <sup>a</sup>fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.
- 17 For athe law was given by Moses, *but* bgrace and ctruth came by Jesus Christ.
- <sup>18</sup> <sup>a</sup>No man hath seen God at any time; <sup>b</sup>the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared *him*.

#### John's Denial That He Was the Christ

- 19 And this is athe record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou?
- 20 And ahe confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ.
- 21 And they asked him, What then? Art thou Elias? And he saith, I am not. Art thou athat prophet? And he answered, No.
- 22 Then said they unto him, Who art thou? that we may give an answer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself?
- 23 He said,  $^{\rm a}$ I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as  $^{\rm b}$ said the prophet Esaias.

- 24 And they which were sent were of the Pharisees.
- 25 And they asked him, and said unto him, Why baptizest thou then, if thou be not that Christ, nor Elias, neither that prophet?
- 26 John answered them, saying, <sup>a</sup>I baptize with water: <sup>b</sup>but there standeth one among you, whom ye know not;
- <sup>27</sup> <sup>a</sup>He it is, who coming after me <sup>1</sup> is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose.
- 28 These things were done <sup>a</sup>in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.

## Behold the Lamb of God

- 29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold athe Lamb of God, bwhich taketh away the sin of the world.
- 30 This is he of whom I said, After me cometh a man which lis preferred before me: for he was before me.
- 31 And I knew him not: but that he should be made manifest to Israel, atherefore am I come baptizing with water.
- 32 <sup>a</sup>And John bare <sup>1</sup>record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it <sup>2</sup>abode upon him.
- 33 And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, athe same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.
- 34 And I saw, and <sup>1</sup>bare record that this is the <sup>3</sup>Son of God.

## Two of John's Disciples Follow Jesus

- 35 Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples;
- 36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, <sup>a</sup>Behold the Lamb of God!

- 37 And the two disciples heard him speak, and they afollowed Jesus.
- 38 Then Jesus turned, and saw them following, and saith unto them, What seek ye? They said unto him, Rabbi, (which is to say, being interpreted, <sup>1</sup>Master,) where <sup>2</sup>dwellest thou?
- 39 He saith unto them, Come and see. They came and saw where he dwelt, and labode with him that day: for it was about the tenth hour.
- 40 One of the two which heard John *speak*, and followed him, was <sup>a</sup>Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.
- 41 He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messias, which is, 'being interpreted, the <sup>2</sup>Christ.
- 42 And he brought him to Jesus. And when Jesus beheld him, he said, Thou art Simon the son of Jona: athou shalt be called Cephas, which is by interpretation, A stone.

# The Calling of Philip and Nathanael

- 43 The day following Jesus <sup>1</sup>would go forth into Galilee, and findeth <sup>a</sup>Philip, and saith unto him, Follow me.
- 44 Now <sup>a</sup>Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.
- 45 Philip findeth <sup>a</sup>Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom <sup>b</sup>Moses in the law, and the <sup>c</sup>prophets, did write, Jesus <sup>d</sup>of Nazareth, the <sup>e</sup>son of Joseph.
- 46 And Nathanael said unto him, <sup>a</sup>Can there any good thing come out of Nazareth? Philip saith unto him, Come and see.
- 47 Jesus saw Nathanael coming to him, and saith of him, Behold <sup>a</sup>an Israelite indeed, in whom is no <sup>1</sup>guile!
- 48 Nathanael saith unto him, <sup>1</sup>Whence knowest thou me? Jesus answered and
