If you are a Christian, and not studying scripture, you are *Sola*. Alone. No different than Christians before the Reformation.

Hebrews 4:12

Enter into God's word for yourself.

Not Bible studies, but Bible study.

2 Timothy 3:14-17

Being taught as a child, instructed by his mentor to continue in the Word.

Is your experience living and active?

Sometimes we only touch our Bibles

Sometimes we hop around

Sometimes we crawl through

But we can

- Walk through scripture - God's word is meant to be savored
select a book to study deeply (like Ephesians, Jonah, John)
memorize
use well accepted commentaries
- Run through scripture - go back and forth, compare themes (for instance - compare Daniel, Revelation, Ezekiel)
- Fly through scripture -
instead of reading through the Bible in the year, try reading through in a month

God's word becomes your daily bread. You will never be alone again.
